

### Day 1 Bucharest - arrival

Arrival and transfer from airport to your hotel. Overnight in Bucharest

### Day 2 Bucharest - city tour

After breakfast, enjoy a half day tour of Bucharest-visit the Village Museum with its 50 buildings representing the history and design of Romania's rural architecture. You will also see The Arc de Triumph, Opera House, University Square, Roman Square, etc. Overnight in Bucharest

Depart for Fagaras, an imposing citadel dating back to the feudal age. Brief stop in Rupea - one of the oldest archaeological sites in Romania. Continue to Crit, a Saxon village filled with traditional houses - enjoy a warm delicious meal. We arrive at Sighisoara, birthplace of Vlad the Impaler - discover the medieval Citadel, included in UNESCO World Heritage: the Clock Tower, the Church on the Hill, the roofed stairways etc... Overnight in Sighisoara.

### Day 5 Sighisoara - Biertan - Alba Iulia - Hunyadi Castle

Morning visit of the fortified Church at Biertan. Route to Alba Iulia, home to a Roman Fort, a medieval defense fortress, and ultimately, a large stellar-shaped fortress with bastions in Romania, built in a Vauban style. Continue to Hunyadi Castle, one of the most well preserved Gothic castles of Transylvania. Transfer to Sibiu and overnight.

### Day 6 Sibiu - Curtea de Arges - Bucharest

Walking tour of the medieval centre of Sibiu, one of Romania's most attractive cities. Leaving Sibiu for Curtea de Arges - Visit of the monastery of Curtea de Arges, a masterpiece of the Romanian architecture. Continue to Bucharest and overnight.

**Day 4 Sapanta - Cluj-Napoca** Our trip will continue with a visit to the Merry Cemetery of Sapanta - perhaps the happiest cemetery in the world, filled with lively-colored tombstones and funny poems and it stands as proof that everything can be funny - even a cemetery. Then, we will visit local craftsmen and admire their beautiful work, witness demonstrations and see the most ingenious natural washing machine that women used to wash their woolen rugs with: the Whirlpools in Maramures. Return to Cluj-Napoca and overnight in (B).

**Day 5 Cluj-Napoca-departure** After breakfast, transfer to Cluj-Napoca airport (B).

**Day 3 Sucevita - Neamt Fortress - Iasi** In the morning, visit Sucevita Monastery, surrounded by fortified walls, built in Moldavian style, with Gothic and Byzantine influences. Next will visit Neamt fortress - an important military and historical objective that survived the siege of Sultan Mehmed II, the conqueror of Constantinople. Then, visit of the private peasant museum of Nicolae Popa, a local sculptor and a true creator of folklore. Here you can be witness to his creation and try on the ritual masks and traditional costumes. Overnight in Iasi (B).

**Day 4: Iasi - departure** Transfer to Iasi airport (B)
